



Vehicle Emergency Supply Kit

In case you are stranded, keep a kit of emergency supplies in your car

- Flares, Triangles, warning device
- Flag or rag to tie to antenna
- Jumper Cables
- Whistle to signal for help
- Fire Extinguisher
- Flash Light w/extra batteries
- First Aid Kit
- Small Tool Kit (pliers, wrench, and screw driver)
- Charged mobile phone and car Charger
- Non-perishable food, protein rich energy bars (baby food, if applicable)
- Duct tape
- Pocket knife
- Tire pressure gauge
- Fix a flat
- Antifreeze/coolant
- Motor oil
- Extra fuses
- Water
- GPS Device
- Container/Duffle Bag for Supplies
- Manual can opener
- Radio – battery or hand cranked and extra batteries
- Compass
- Hand sanitizer
- Safety Vest
- Local map
- Matches in a water proof container

Seasonal Supplies

- Clothes – warm clothes, gloves, hat boots, jacket, heavy socks
- Ice scraper
- Sand/rock salt/ (non-clumping)/kitty litter
- Hand warmers
- Sleeping bag, blanket, snow suit...
- Small shovel and small broom

Keep your car in good mechanical condition

- At least ½ tank of gas at all times
- Good tires
- Good battery and ignition system
- Good windshield wiper blades
- Windshield fluids
- Brakes
- Exhaust system
- Lights/flashing hazards

Watch the news; check the weather conditions before you go. What's it doing now? What's it going to do before you get home? Plan for it!
